| SB1011[apps.azleg.gov] : municipalities; partisan elections (Kavanagh) | Allows cities to run elections with candidates that indicate their political affiliation. | Neutral | | Heard in Senate Government Committee Passed 6-2 | Permissive – municipalities would have the option to use or not use |
| SB1025[apps.azleg.gov] : political signs; tourism zones (Kavanagh) | Cities cannot exceed 10% of total land area for a tourism zone. | Opposed | | Introduced | More restrictive than current laws |
| HB2003[apps.azleg.gov] : corporate income tax; rates (Livingston) | Cuts corporate income tax to match individual income tax | Opposed | | Introduced | Reduces tax revenue. |
| HB2061[apps.azleg.gov] : food; municipal tax; exemption (Biasiucci) | Preempts cities or towns from levying a tax for food for home consumption. | Opposed | | Introduced | Reduces tax revenue. |
| HB2067[apps.azleg.gov] : residential leases; | Preempts cities and towns from levying taxes on residential rentals. | Opposed | | Introduced | Reduces tax revenue. |
