1. House is adjourned until May 15
2. Session will likely remain open due to ongoing budget discussions and waiting for May numbers
3. There may be a resolution initiated by the League regarding the Clerk's ability to enforce strict compliance with referendum initiatives resulting from the Voice of Surprise case

HB2677 – abortion ban; repeal	Repeals criminal statute prohibiting abortion-related conduct that is not necessary to save the life of the mother.			Signed by Governor 05.02.2024	
HB2719 – bond elections; date; voter turnout	Establishes additional requirements for bond issuance elections and elections to authorize indebtedness.	Opposed		There has been no activity since March 26 and is likely now dead
